

The intravenous sedation that you will be given for your endoscopic procedure is highly effective in preventing discomfort during the procedure. The major effects wear off rapidly and side effects such as nausea or vomiting are uncommon.

However, minor effects on memory, balance and muscle function may persist for some hours. These effects vary from person to person, are not individually predictable and will be of more significance if you have existing muscle problems or balance disorders.

It is illegal for you to drive on the day of the procedure. You must not operate machinery or sign important documents.
